Principles:

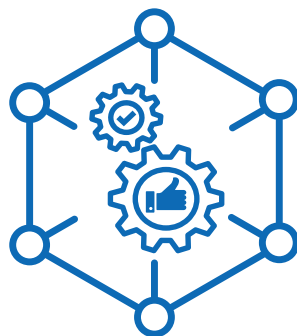
- Facilitate the school and social integration of migrant students.
